IETF DMARC Activity

- Draft: DMARC Extension for Public Suffix Domains
 - Several updates, publication is pending
- Draft: DMARC Use of the RFC5322 .Sender Header
 - Allow domains to signal DMARC alignment with `Sender:` and `From:` address
 - Would allow Intermediaries to alter `From:` header without failing DMARC alignment

- Work on DMARCBis increasing
 - Moving DMARC to Internet Standard track



Farsight Security DNS Data

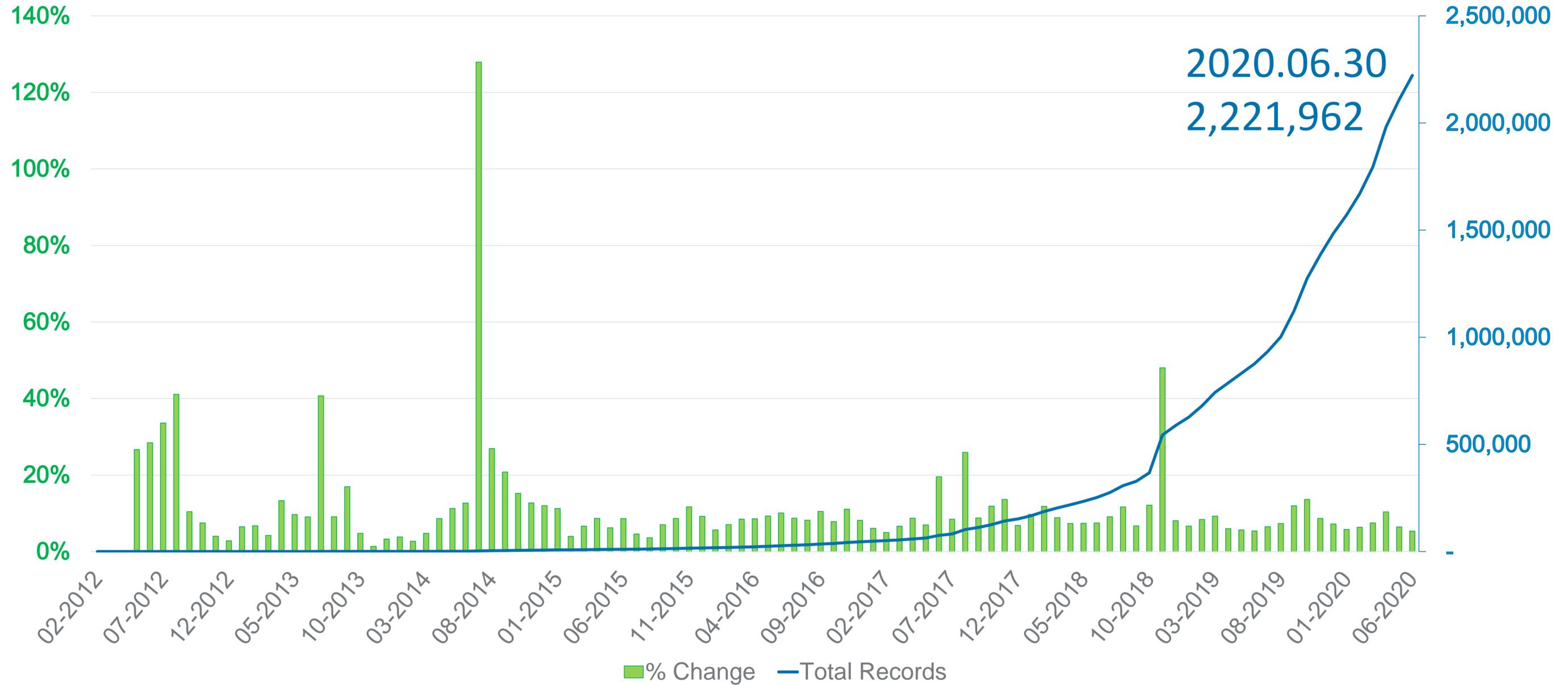
- Sensors located at network providers around the world
- Response data – the answer – is timestamped and stored
- Sensors only see records when somebody looks them up

- DMARC.org only includes valid records still published in DNS, and are tracked by when they were first published
 - The set of active records changes over time



Active DMARC Records – 2Q 2020

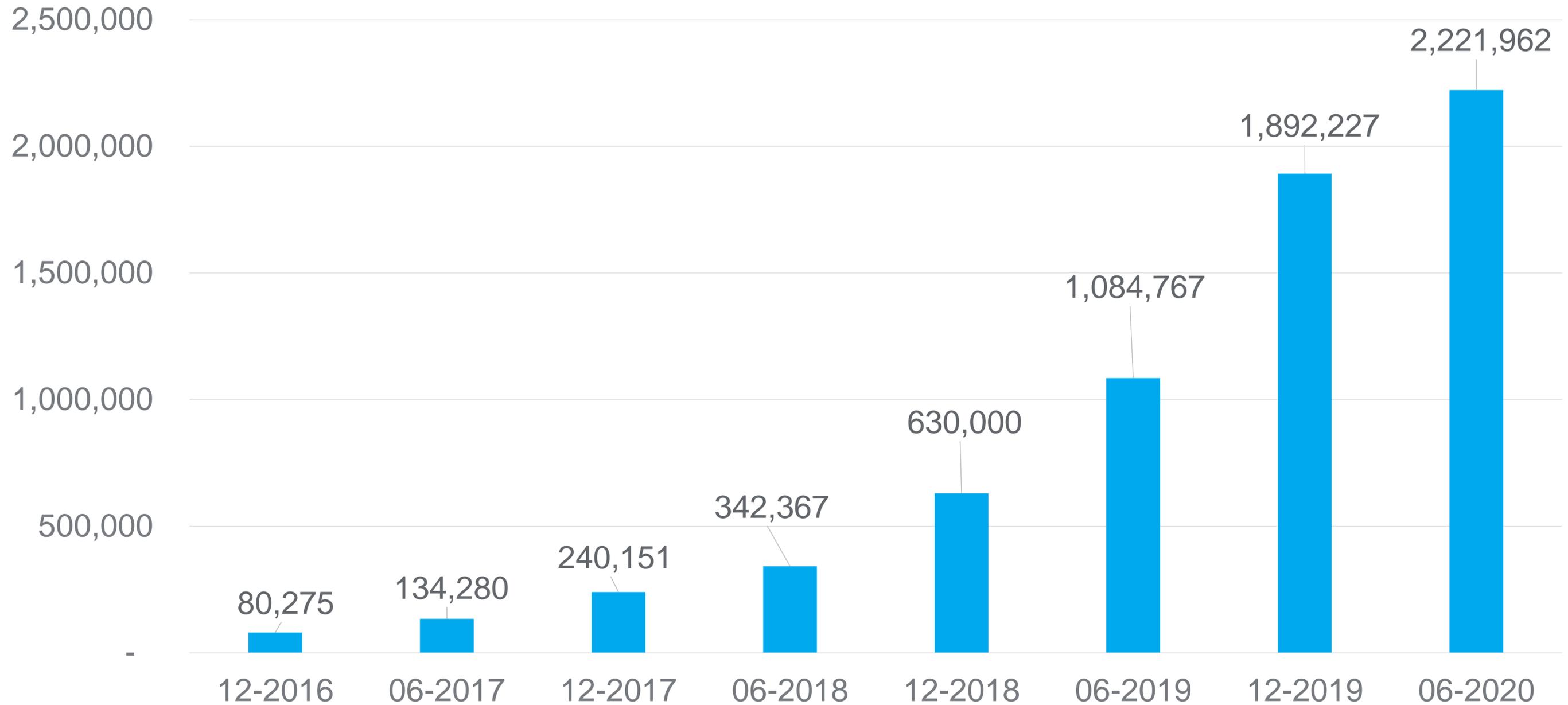
Active DMARC Records and % Growth by Month

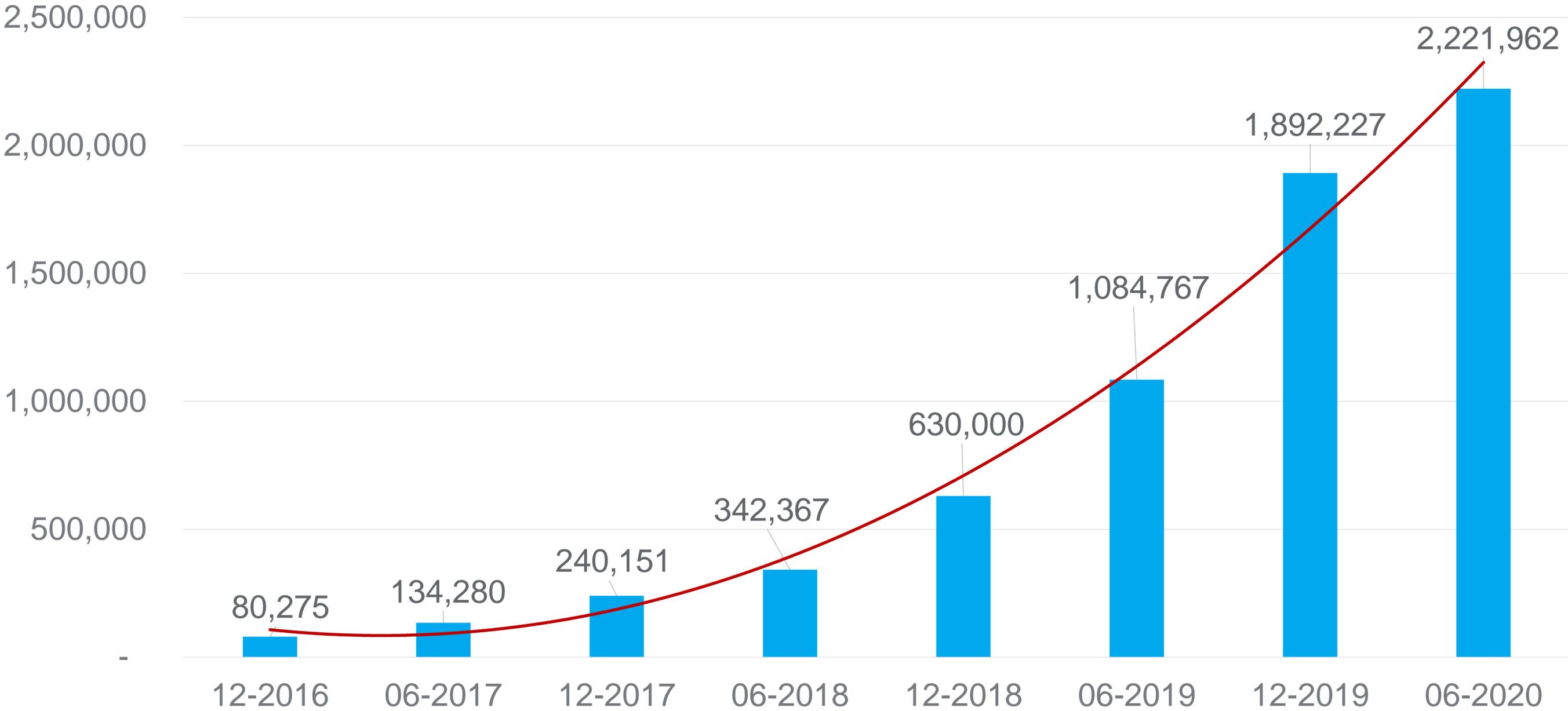
Active DMARC Record Growth

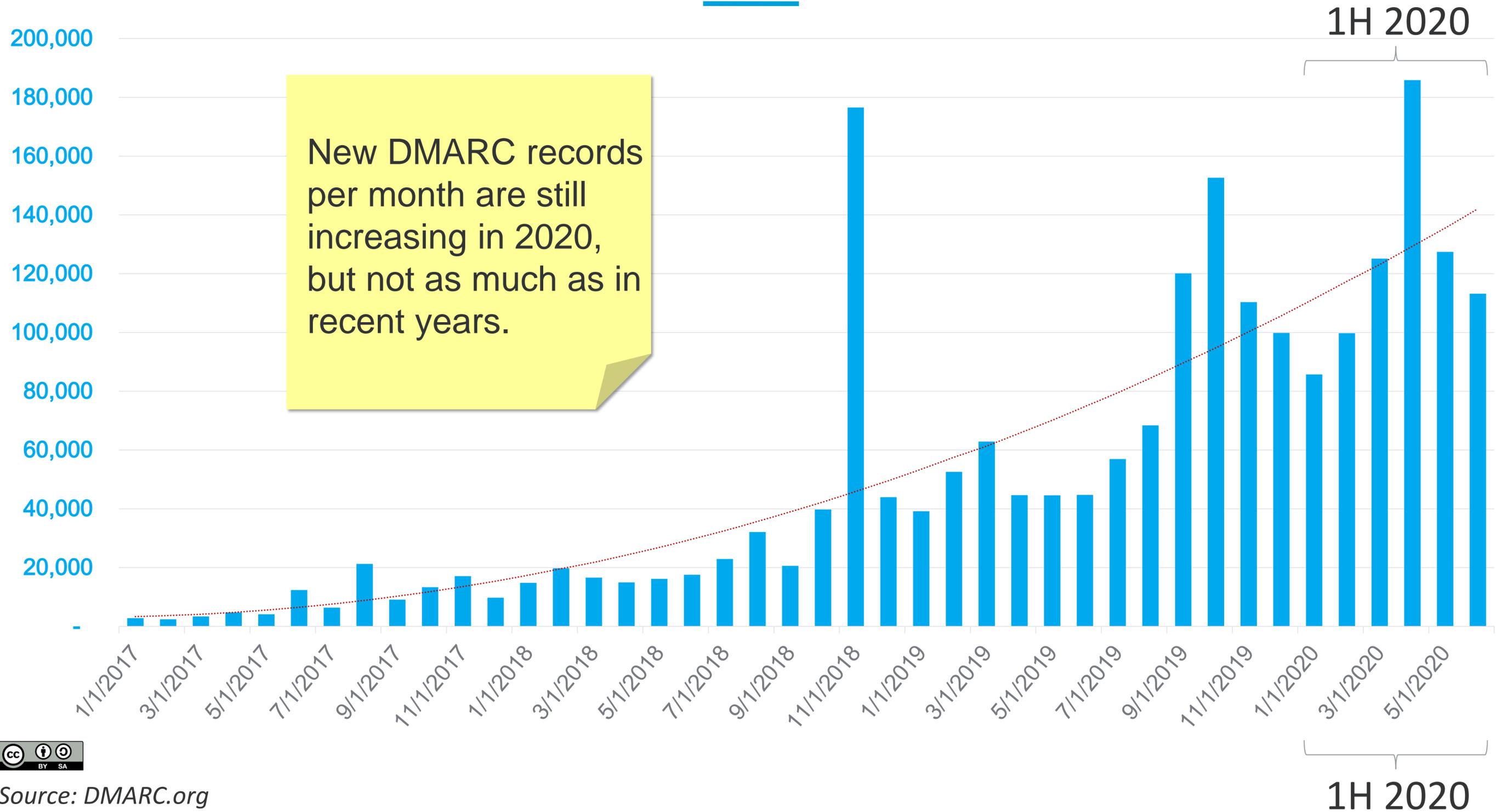

- Pandemic related? Will it continue through 2H 2020?



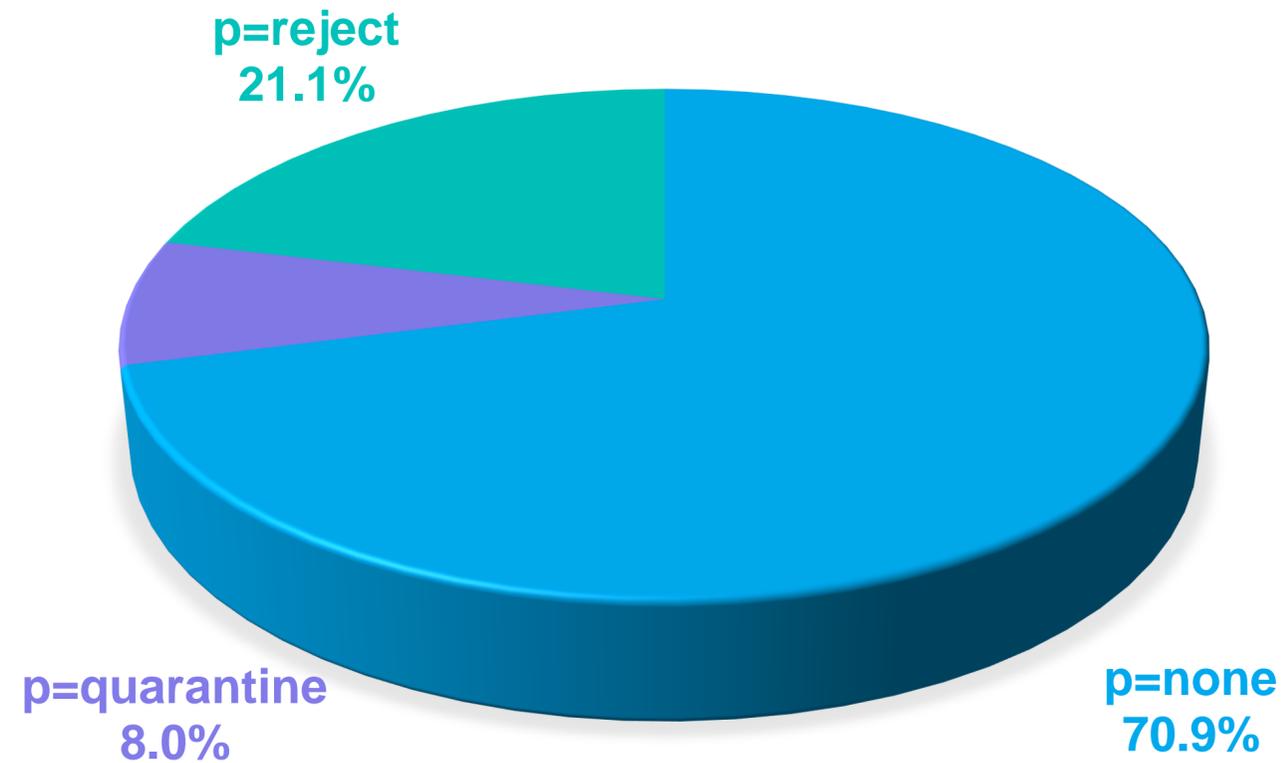
New DMARC Records Each Month



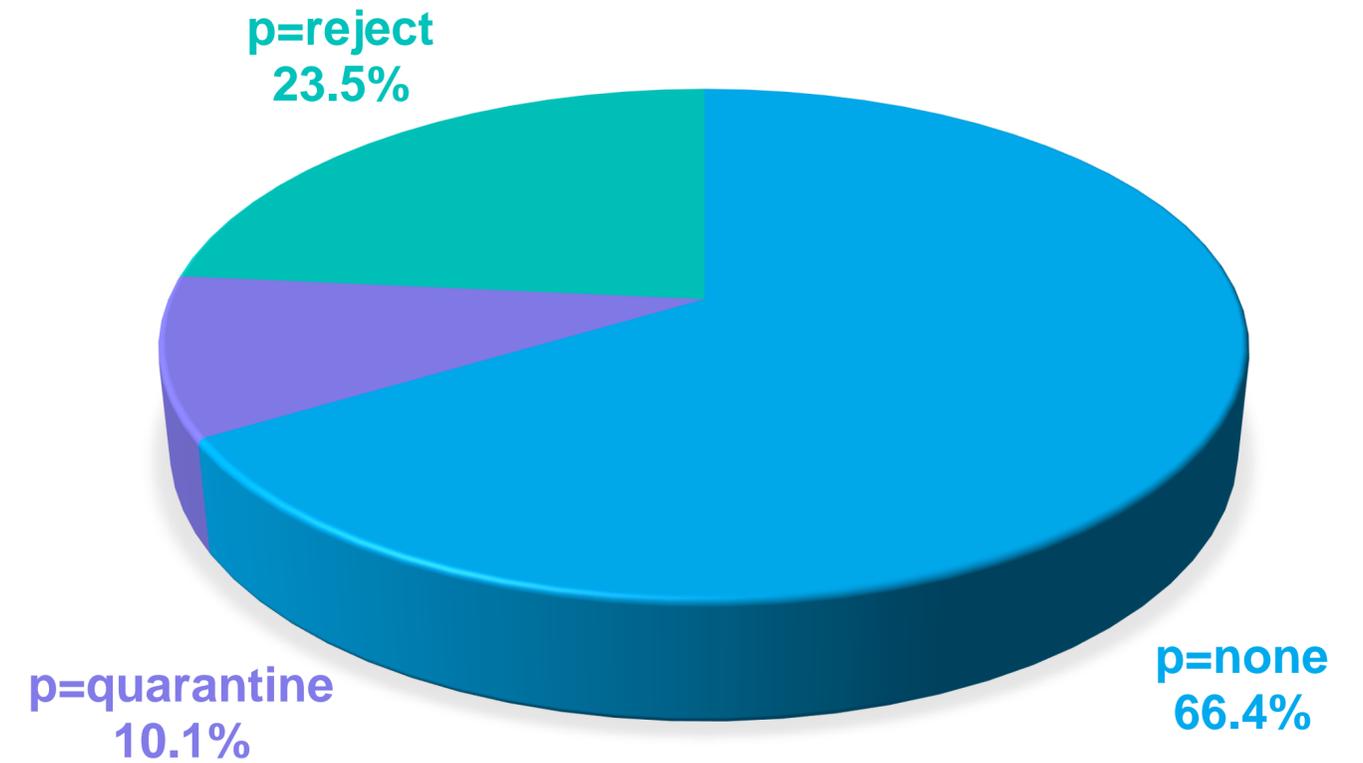

2019.12.31



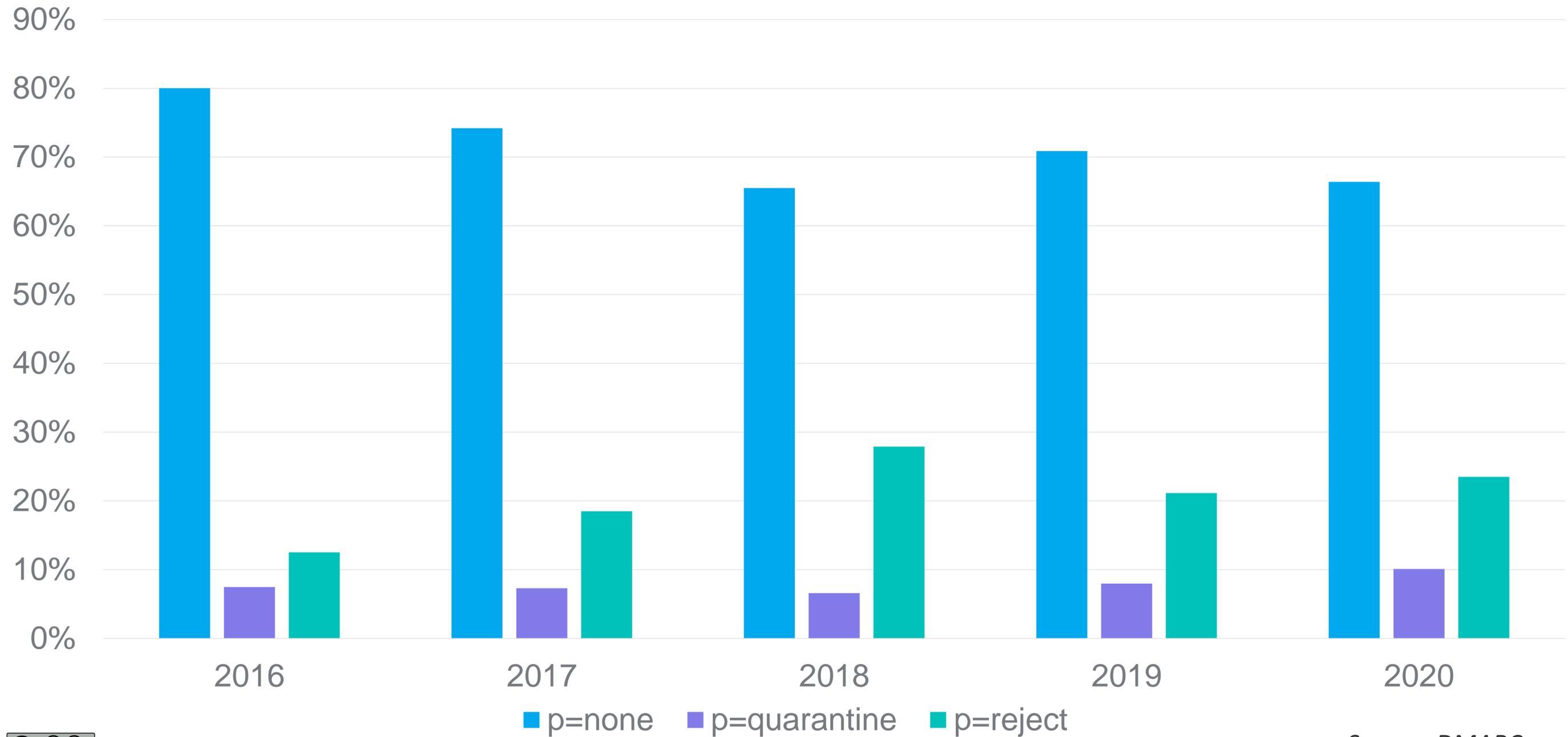

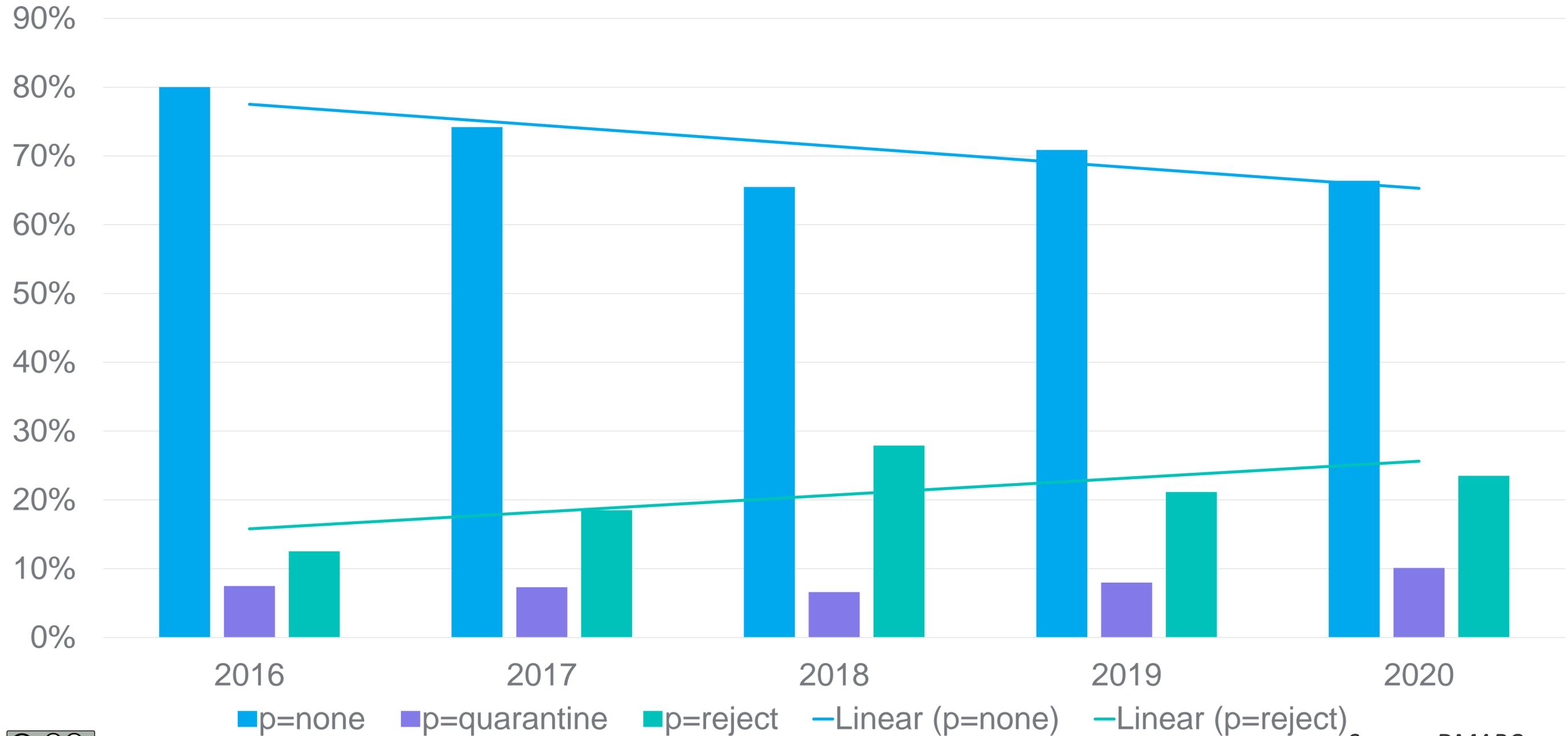
DMARC Policies By Year

- IETF's `ietf@ietf.org` mailing list
 - First message 2019.06.25 from Office 365 customer
 - 4.7% of posts since then had an ARC Seal

2020

- IETF's `ietf@ietf.org` mailing list
 - 7,956 messages since 2019.06.25
 - 5.8% of posts since then had an ARC Seal

Several groups are looking into ways to measure ARC adoption
